Annual Inspections

In August 2020 the Board of Directors will be conducting exterior property inspections. Some of the items we look for are:

1. Mold on siding
2. Cracked or chipping foundations
3. Broken, rotted or cracked trim and shutters
4. Faded paint on shutters, window trim, or foundations
5. Overgrown foliage to include tree branches over the sidewalk
6. Excess trash or debris

You can be proactive by addressing some of these cosmetic items on your home as soon as possible.

Take a look at your overall garden appearance. Adding mulch around the trees, and trimming your trees will give your property and our community a more pleasant appearance.
